Group Discussion Questions:

1. Which of God's many attributes encourages you to praise Him? What can you do to practice praising God knowing all of His perfect characteristics?
2. What are some of the difficulties that hinder you from living a life of praise?
3. What do you think it practically looks like to continually have the praise of the Most High God coming through your lips as this verse in Hebrews is instructing?
4. In light of the Philippians 4:8 verse, how can we keep our thoughts on things that are true, honorable, just, pure, lovely, commendable and excellent? Can you identify an area of your life where you take your eyes off our purpose – to glorify God and enjoy him forever? Are there forms of media that are time-wasters for you?

Personal Study & Application:

1. Pray for the Lord to give you a soft heart that is unashamed of living out a life of praise. Spend some time listening for God to reveal some of the difficulties or distractions in your life that hinder praise to Him.
2. Decide on one practical way you can implement praising God into your life more than you do today.
3. Find time to dwell on the character of God and see how that may help you to develop a greater heart of praise for Him.
4. Find one passage of Scripture you can hide in your heart to battle your sin. Pray that the Holy Spirit would help you remember the Word hidden in your heart when temptations arise.
