

Zacharias, Ravi. *Can Man Live Without God*. Nashville, TN: W Publishing Group, 1994.

Whether you are dealing with an atheist or have honest questions about God, this is a great book to read. The author's goal is to break through the intellectual smoke screens and get to the real question – Does my life have meaning? Or to put it another way – Can man live without God? The book is divided up into three sections: 1) Antitheism, 2) What gives life meaning, and 3) Who is Jesus? In the tradition of C. S. Lewis and Francis Schaeffer, Zacharias has the ability to weave together philosophy, theology, literature and culture making it interesting and meaningful. I was encouraged in my faith and was reminded that every human has a need to meaning in life and only God can satisfy that enormous need.
